W Series, the international single-seater motor racing championship for female drivers, is set to return to Channel 4. Channel 4 will carry coverage from all eight W Series races this year with the first race coming from the Red Bull Ring in Austria on 26 June

Channel 4 will also broadcast highlights of the Formula 1 race from the Red Bull Ring on 27 June giving race fans the chance to watch the world's best male and female drivers in action on the same platform.

The W Series presenting line up, led by Lee McKenzie & Anna Woolhouse, features 13-time Formula 1 Grand Prix winner David Coulthard and also includes: Alex Jaques, Amy Reynolds, Billy Monger, Naomi Schiff and Ted Kravitz.

### **MONEY TALKS**

Award-winning actress, writer and theatre director Kathy Burke is returning to Channel 4 for a new two-part documentary in which she'll delve deep into the world of money. Who has it? Who doesn't? Who deserves it and who definitely doesn't? And who has won, and lost it all?

We are a society obsessed with the pursuit of wealth and yet we sometimes demonise those that don't have it and sneer at those who have recently acquired it. Some won't talk about theirs at all. As a society, we have a very complex relationship with cash, one that cuts through all classes.

In **Kathy Burke: Rich and Poor** (2 x 60' w/t), Kathy wants to understand why we treat people differently based on how much money they have... or don't have? And after the biggest global crisis of a century, will our attitudes change?

Born into very little and now wealthy and successful, Kathy says she's perfectly happy with what she's got, and doesn't understand why people worship money or feel they have to spend their lives earning ever more. Across the two episodes, Kathy will aim to meet a raft of people across a broad spectrum of wealth – from the very affluent to those living below the breadline.

### **THIS WAY UP**

Sharon Horgan and Aisling Bea reunite their sister act for the Merman-produced comedy.

Aisling Bea's Merman-produced comedy co-starring Sharon Horgan has been commissioned for a second series (6 x 30) for Channel 4 and Hulu. Bea took home the Breakthrough Talent BAFTA Craft award for writing series one earlier this year.

In the forthcoming series, viewers can expect more bittersweet sister-related shenanigans, including ill-advised trips to infra-red saunas, and possibly another sung duet... to give the people what they want.

Series two is set after the events of the series one finale, with things in flux for Aine (Aisling Bea, *Living With Yourself*; *Quiz*) and her sister, Shona (Sharon Horgan, *Catastrophe*; *Military Wives*).

Aine's starting to leave her time in rehab behind and live less cautiously, which may not be entirely wise. Will she and Richard (Tobias Menzies, *The Crown*; *Game of Thrones*) make a cheeky go of it? Or continue to exist in the odd tension of the employer-employee dynamic? Or is emotional risk the "sexy bit"?



At the end of series one we saw Shona newly engaged after Vish's (Aasif Mandvi, *Evil*; *The Brink*) proposal, despite sharing a stolen kiss with business partner, Charlotte (Indira Varma, *Game of Thrones*; *Luther*). How will Charlotte and Shona manage running a new business together after \*that\* kiss? Will Shona be able to go through with marrying Vish? Planning a wedding? Can she tell him what happened? Is there anything more to tell?

Despite the sisters' numerous ups and downs, *This Way Up* centres on the unshakable bond between Aine and Shona and their passionate, caring, often-angry, always-hilarious relationship. In the darkest moments, when faced with overwhelming loneliness and sadness, the two sisters will always save each other and bring each other back into the light.

### **LIVE BRITISH FORMULA 1**

Steve Jones, with David Coulthard, Mark Webber, Billy Monger and Lee McKenzie, presents live coverage from Silverstone as the cars take to one of the most prestigious tracks on the Formula 1 calendar. Lewis Hamilton will be looking to get his Championship fight back on track as he attempts to win his 8th Title and become the best ever in F1. Max Verstappen, leading the Championship will have something to say about that in a dominant Season so far for red Bull. This will also be the first F1 Weekend Ever to replace a Saturday Qualifying Session with a Sprint Race to determine Sunday's grid. All of Friday, Saturday and Sunday's action will be Live on Channel 4!

### DECEIT

Niamh Algar leads the cast in a gripping 4-part piece examining the controversial honeytrap at the heart of one of Britain's most high-profile cases.

Channel 4 has commissioned Deceit a new 4X60' drama written by Emilia di Girolamo (The Tunnel) and produced by Story Films, which examines the high-pressure investigation into the devastating murder of Rachel Nickell in 1992. Examining the complicated and toxic sexual politics of the early '90s and the police's obsession with the wrong man, Deceit enters a dysfunctional world, where a female undercover officer, codename 'Lizzie James', is asked to become sexual bait for a suspected killer.

Five months on from the crime and The Met Police are still no closer to capturing the man they're convinced is responsible. First identified through a BBC Crimewatch appeal, the evidence is stacked against Colin Stagg. The media feed a national obsession, covering every detail of the case and demanding justice. The police are determined to catch the man who, in their eyes, is guilty before he kills again. In desperation, the relatively young Detective Inspector leading the case, engages the nation's most famous criminal profiler to devise a bold undercover operation which will see an attractive, young female officer start a relationship with Colin Stagg.

Growing up under Thatcher's reign, with second-wave feminism 'Lizzie James' (Niamh Algar – The Virtues, Raised by Wolves and Calm with Horses) – is determined to rise through the ranks. But the early '90s has brought with it an inevitable backlash in the shape of 'Lad Culture', obliterating any feminist gains and putting women firmly back in their place.

Hugely ambitious, 'Lizzie' has found a way to stand out by becoming one of very few female undercover officers deployed in covert operations... And then she's offered a central role in the biggest murder enquiry the country has ever seen...

With access to previously unheard audio, video and written materials, Deceit includes scenes of verbatim dialogue as part of a fictionalised retelling of events, taking viewers behind the scenes of one of the UK's most flawed and controversial police investigations.

### HOW CAN I IMPROVE MY MEMORY

Hosted by **Sandi Toksvig**, the brand-new series of Can I Improve My Memory? is set to air this Summer on Channel 4.

Over the course of the series, five famous faces from the world of TV, entertainment and sport will enter one of the trickiest competitions on TV designed to improve their memories. Coached by real masters of memory who share the secrets of their success and change the way the celebrity contestants think, they will be given just one week (each episode) to memorise hundreds of niche facts and master mind-bending techniques before being put on the spot in rigorous quiz conditions by Sandi at Memory HQ. Across four knockout episodes, the challenges will get tougher and the group will be whittled down to just one celebrity being crowned Memory Champion by Sandi.

Competing to win the coveted Memory Champion title are; Strictly Come Dancing legend **Len Goodman**, boxing heavyweight **Chris Eubank**, TV presenter **Anna Richardson**, EastEnders actor **Nina Wadia**, ex beautician and Love Island Winner **Amber Gill**.



In the first episode, the celebrities must master general knowledge topics they know nothing about, followed by a quickfire challenge, tackling that common memory demon – names and faces. In this episode, Anna must become an expert in planetary science, including memorising information about the major and dwarf planets, the solar systems, names of moons and historical details about The Space Race. Amber will have to spread her wings into ornithology, memorising the Latin names of common and rare British bird species, their wing spans, bird calls and decipher their plumages. Len is challenged with remembering hundreds of facts about American hip hop in the 1990s, Nina attempts to crack facts on the human skeleton and Chris will be memorising information about dinosaurs of the Jurassic era. To assist them with their daunting tasks, the celebrity contestants will be coached by **Ed Cooke**, who became a Grand Master of Memory at just 23 years of age. With an abundance of nerves and nail-biting tension, just how much can the celebrity contestants remember and who will win?

### **CHANGING ROOMS**

The full line-up of presenter, designers and DIY expert for Channel 4's new version of the iconic '90s and '00s home-DIY series Changing Rooms has been confirmed.

Joining returning Changing Rooms favourite Laurence Llewelyn-Bowen to give the show a fresh lick of paint is host Anna Richardson and designers Jordan Cluroe and Russell Whitehead of 2LG Studio.

Completing the team is carpenter and joiner Tibby Singh.

Changing Rooms, a Shine TV production, is made in partnership with Dulux and sees two sets of homeowners from the same neighbourhood work against the clock to renovate a room in each other's houses.

The homeowners will work with LLB or 2LG to bring the new looks to life in the chosen rooms, with the designers' bold and opposing styles ensuring each transformation will be spectacular, innovative and unexpected.

Carpenter and joiner Tibby Singh will lend a helping hand to bring the designs to life, while presenter Anna Richardson will guide viewers through the makeovers and hear from the homeowners throughout the process to see how they're feeling about the renovations they're carrying out, and what might be going on back in their own home.

Changing Rooms will be packed full of design and DIY hints and tips, teaching us how to be crafty on a budget by upscaling and adding sparkle to unloved or outdated corners of our homes.

Changing Rooms is a 6 x 60' primetime series. It was commissioned for Channel 4, in partnership with Dulux, by Jonny Rothery. It will be made by Shine TV (part of Banjay UK) and executive produced by Mark Sammon and Katie Brosnan, the series producer is James Kane.

### **SECRETS OF THE LONDON UNDERGROUND**

UKTV has commissioned, *Secrets of the London Underground* (6x60') for its leading factual channel, Yesterday. The UKTV Original series will be produced by prominent UK independent production company, Brown Bob Productions.

In the new series, railway historian Tim Dunn (*The Architecture The Railways Built*) and Siddy Holloway from the London Transport Museum will explore hidden areas of the London Underground that - despite being just feet away from where millions of people regularly travel - hardly anyone knows about.

The pair will explore abandoned tunnels, secret bunkers and hidden staircases that have been concealed from public view for years. They will use their unique and privileged access to tell the story of places including London's most clandestine tube station; the former terminus of the world's first electric railway; and a station now only accessible by getting a train driver to stop at just the right place, but which played a key role during the Second World War.
