- 8pm & 9pm slots grew week-on-week across Mon-Thu
- Dominated 9pm on Friday once again!

New Series

- Week 1 of Kathy Burke: Money Talks is our biggest title in the Monday 10pm slot this year
- Series 2 of original comedy and instant boxset This Way Up returned on Wednesday at 10pm with 57% of viewers Women
- While *Can I Improve My Memory?* was up vs slot for Upmarkets and grew share from the one-off last year

On Going

- Counter-scheduling against a summer of reality and live sport continues to reap rewards with significant series on series growth for *The Handmaid's Tale*
- Devon & Cornwall consolidating strongly in the Monday 8pm slot and this weeks episode up +30% wow
- 24 hours in A&E also grew wow as the schedule began to settle as did Bake Off: The Professionals and 999: What's Your Emergency?
- Grand Designs on wed at 9pm was up +220% week-on-week with 1m/6%
- Celeb Gogglebox drew the biggest audience of the week winning the Fri 9pm slot for individuals and abc1's
- The Last Leg delivered a slot winning 1634 share at 10pm
- Saturday evening's *Lake District Farm Shop* with over 1m for the 2nd consecutive week with week 1 attracting the biggest share in the slot for 4 years

Sport

Live coverage of the British GP drew the biggest audience of the season with the W
 Series also hitting a new High

Digital

- Rick & Morty is still delivering a huge share of 1634's on E4 with week 3 a new high of 21%. while week 4's live 7% was up +100% vs slot
- My Floating Home on More4 returned up almost +100% vs slot for ABC1 share
- While Deadpool 2 was the biggest film of the week on Film4. Up over +100% vs slot for 1634 share



All 4 Performance Highlights



Week 12.07.21 - 18.07.21

- Views are up 12% week-on-week this is most likely due to the Euro's & Wimbledon finishing but also benefitting from new shows like *This Way Up* and the live coverage of the *British F1*
- Views compared to the same week last year is up +6%, growth from all content types except Archive but the most noticeable growth is from Simulcast (+48%) which is mainly driven by the *F1* which makes it into the Top 10 this week
- The Handmaid's Tale remains the number one show on All 4 week-on-week for its fifth consecutive week despite the show launching on Wednesday night
- This Way Up sees it take third place in the Top 10 shows this week with impressive views
- Rick & Morty is up +26% week-on-week with the most recent episode (Ep5) delivering the most views of any episode in the current series (0-7 days O&O)
- The return of **Below Deck** on E4 sees it make a return to the Top 10 on All 4 this week
