- Views by comparison to the same week last year are down -5%, however there has been growth
 from First Run, Exclusives and Simulcast but Archive which is down -24% is bringing down the set
- The Handmaid's Tale is down slightly week-on-week however it has still managed to bring in an impressive 2M+ views week-on-week
- Rick & Morty sees the most growth week-on-week within the Top 10, up +51%. Ep 2 was up +3% 0-6 Days owned & operated vs the same ep from last series
- The first 5 eps of Bake Off: The Professionals are up +18% vs the same eps last series (0-7 Days 0&O)
